Junior Team Tennis (JTT) is the largest youth tennis league in America. It offers girls and boys ages 6 to 18 - beginners to advanced players - the opportunity to play on teams in local competitions that emphasize fun, fitness and friends.



Ages and Divisions Offered

8 & Under

QuickStart Play Format

(play on 36' courts using "red" foam or low bounce balls and 21"-23" racquets)

10 & Under

QuickStart Play Format

(play on 60' courts using "orange" medium bounce balls and 23"-25" racquets)

12 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

14 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

18 & Under

Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced

Beginner - players with no tournament experience

Intermediate - players participating in local and ZAT tournaments

Advanced - players qualified to play in Champ and Super Champ level tournaments

Format of Play

8 & Under and 10 & Under QuickStart

These divisions will participate in round robin team playdays. (Teams will need a minimum of 3 players per team match.)

12 & Under Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

Each team match will consist of 3 lines of singles and 2 lines of

doubles. Each line will play an 8-game pro set using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 7-7. (The home team will need to reserve 3 courts for the match. Teams will need between 4-6 players per team match.)

14 & Under and 18 & Under Beginner

Each team match will consist of 3 lines of singles and 2 lines of doubles. Each line will play an 8-game pro set using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 7-7. (The home team will need to reserve 3 courts for the match. Teams will need between 4-6 players per team match.)

14 & Under and 18 & Under Intermediate & Advanced

Each team match will consist of 1 line of boys' singles, 1 line of girls' singles, 1 line of boys' doubles, 1 line of girls' doubles and 1 line of mixed doubles. Each line will play an 8-game pro set using no-ad scoring with a tiebreak at 7-7. (The home team will need to reserve 3 courts for the match. Teams will need a minimum of 3 boys and 3 girls per team match.)

NOTE: In any team match, a player may play a maximum of 1 line of singles and 1 line of doubles.

JTT Fees

The local league fee is **\$35** per player. This includes the cost of a USTA Junior Team Tennis Nike Dry-Fit shirt. If a player has already played in 2010, he/she may opt out of purchasing an additional shirt. This will automatically deduct \$11.50 from the league fee.

All participants must be members of the USTA. Junior membership fees are \$19 per year and include special benefits and discounts. Visit www.usta.com/membership for more information.

Registration

Fall registration opens August 1st. Teams must have the minimum number of players registered by September 1st to be placed on the schedule. Players may continue to register through September 19th.
